SBI Foundation has partnered with Indian Medical and Scientific Research Foundation for conducting 20,000 high performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) Thalassemia tests in Rajkot, Saurashtra Region in Gujarat.

The main objectives of the project are:

Community awareness, Counselling and making Screening mandatory for the persons of marriageable is an important part of the project as it helps in informing the community about the disease, overcome the stigma of being a carrier of the disorder and prevent the spread of the disease in future generations.

- To create an eco-system that develops Social and Institutional processes to mitigate the damages of Thalassemia and
- To reduce the incidence of inherited blood disease, thereby, preventing Thalassemia major births.
